

# Managing Your Waste

1

Store waste carefully in closed bins, do not put it out loose on the street



2

Sharp objects and broken glass must be contained before putting them in the bin



3

Only put waste out just before a collection is due



4

Place your rubbish bin where requested by your local authority for collection (e.g. on the edge of your property)



5

Use recycling bins where supplied for recyclable materials



6

If having waste removed by tradesmen ensure that they have a valid waste carrier number. Check it with the Environment Agency on 08708 506506



7

Contact your local authority to have bulky waste collected or take it yourself to one of the household waste recycling sites in your area



8

Remember many electrical retailers will now take your old appliance when purchasing a new one from them



Failure to comply with your local authority's requirements on rubbish collection can carry a fine of up to £1000 or a Fixed Penalty Notice of £75-£110

Failure to ensure tradesmen disposing of your waste are registered waste carriers can carry a fine of £5000
